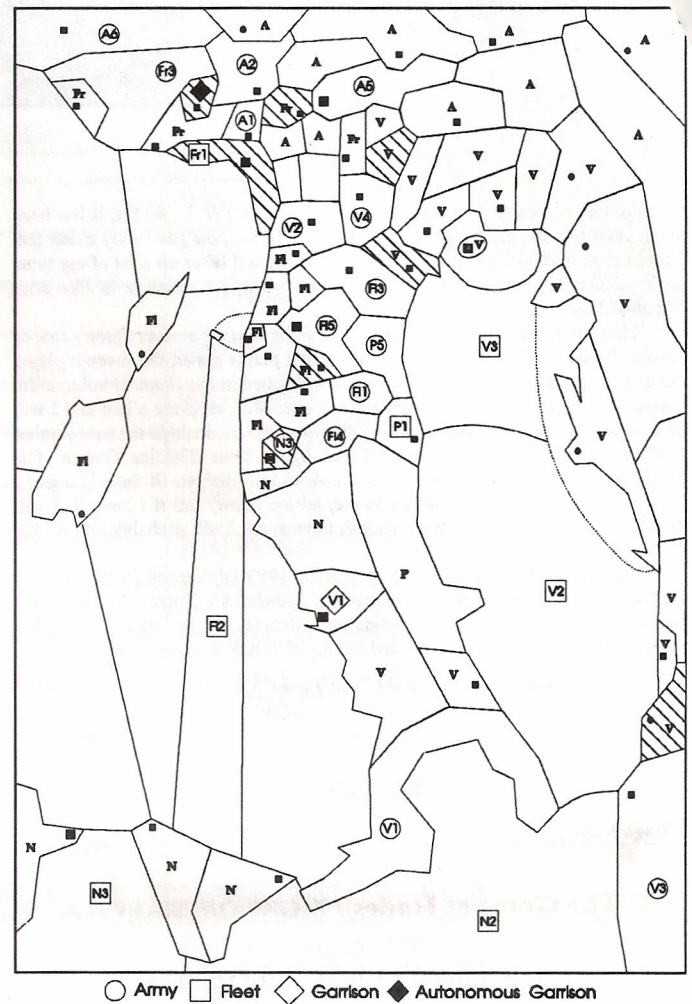

Austria - World except Venice: Venice must be pushed hard NOW or mister money bags is going to romp when Austria and I are assassinated.

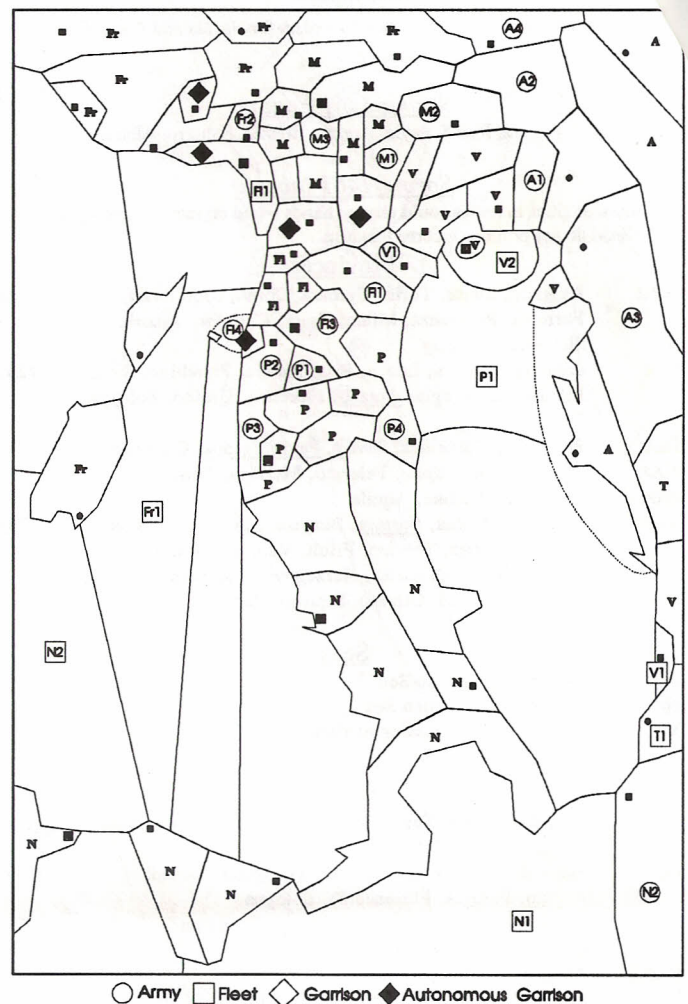

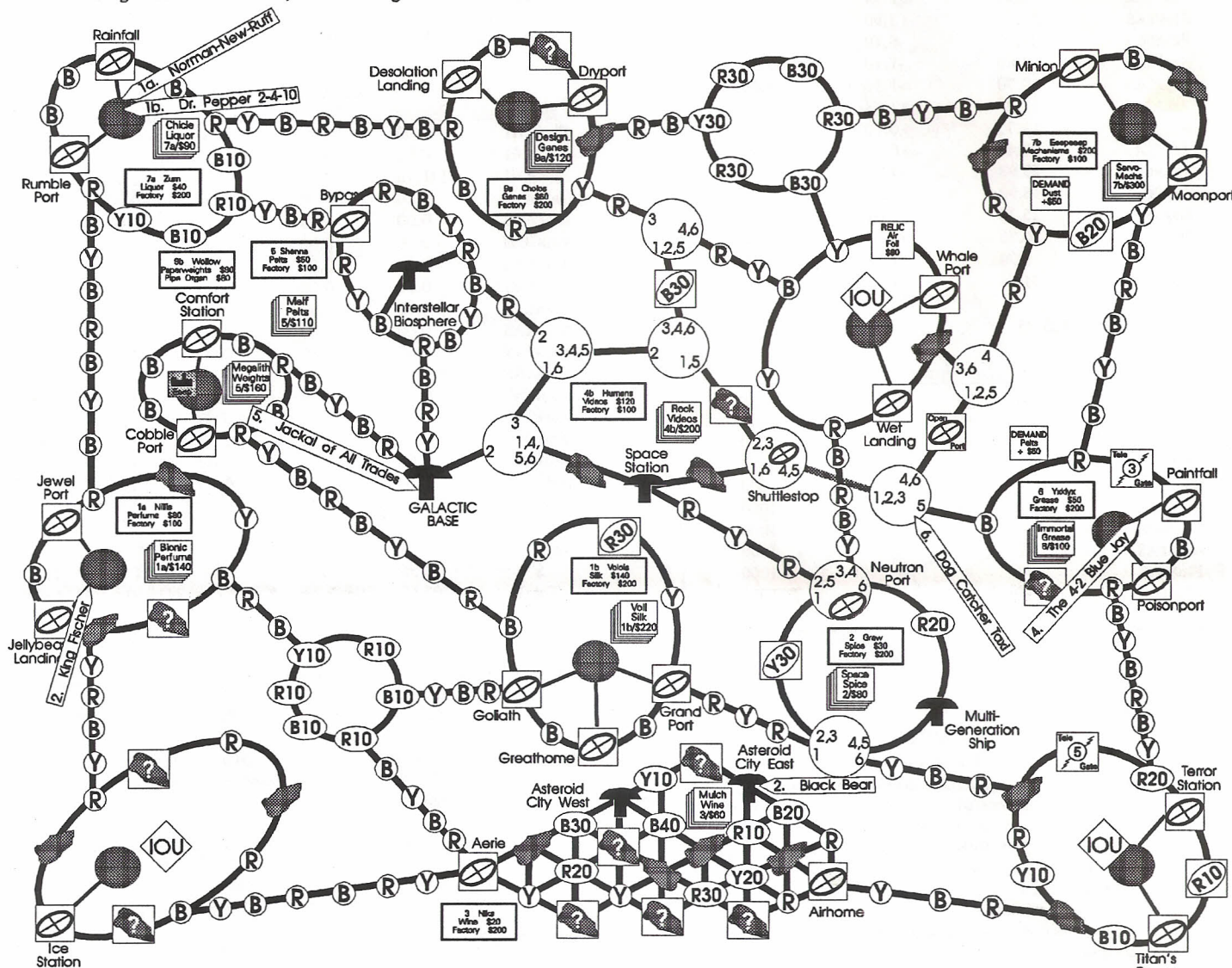

Notes

Remember that an agent takes up half a hold just like a fare does. For future reference, if you try to buy in excess of available holds, the buy order will fail. The contents of a hold will not be accidentally jettisoned.

Cerberus - King Fischer: And at that, it was too long.

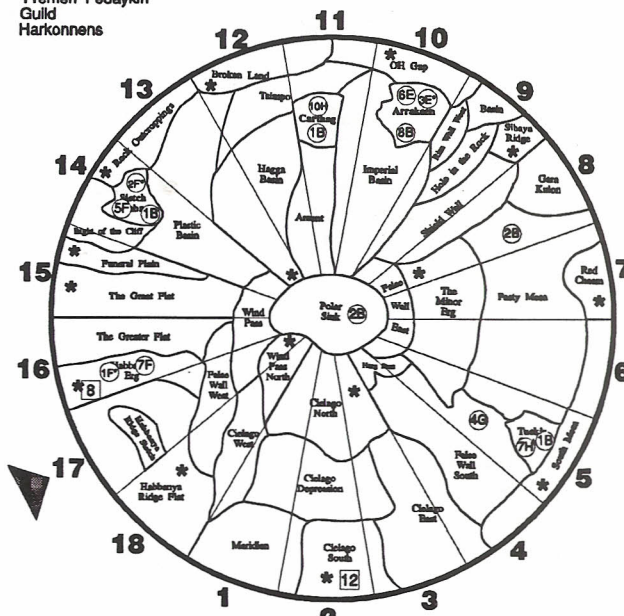
